This temporary position is in support of a statewide program to test drinking water in Indiana schools for lead contamination. Lead contamination in drinking water is a fixture-specific (i.e., leaching from plumbing) rather than source-water problem, and we are seeking experienced water-resources professionals to conduct sampling using the highest standards. This is a targeted recruiting effort for northwest (Gary, Michigan City), northern (South Bend, Elkhart), or northeastern (Ft. Wayne) Indiana, serving urban and rural public schools in northern Indiana

The successful applicant will assist the Regional Coordinator as part of a two-person team in developing sample designs for schools and collecting water samples. Sampling work days will start in the early morning hours, prior to the start of the school day. The successful applicant will be trained and tested on water-sample collection procedures in accordance with standards set by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management.
